Enclosed are your Arrival Time Reports for the first quarter of 2004, and a chart that graphs your arrival performance in Latrobe. As you know, there are two goals of our program. First, we need to continuously improve efficiencies at the breweries by arriving on time for dock appointments. Secondly, we need to improve the level of service to our customers by having our carriers make appointments and deliver the product without delay.

To measure how well you have been making the scheduled dock appointments in Latrobe, the enclosed report outlines each order and compares scheduled vs. actual arrival times. From these records, we calculate the number of times your driver arrived early, on time, and late. Please note the "Percentage of not on time" includes early trucks and is not considered a demerit.

I have marked your reports with the percentage late. As you can see, your March score of **2.1%** marks well with against our monthly average of 5%. Moreover, out of 291 loads picked-up in the first quarter, Pleasant was late for only 9, or 3%. This truly demonstrates your commitment to excellent service. It makes us happy to ship "The Pleasant way".

Sales of Rolling Rock products produced in Latrobe has increased and we are preparing for a record year. We can only accomplish this with your help and support. Please be prepared to handle up to 25% more loads over last year.
